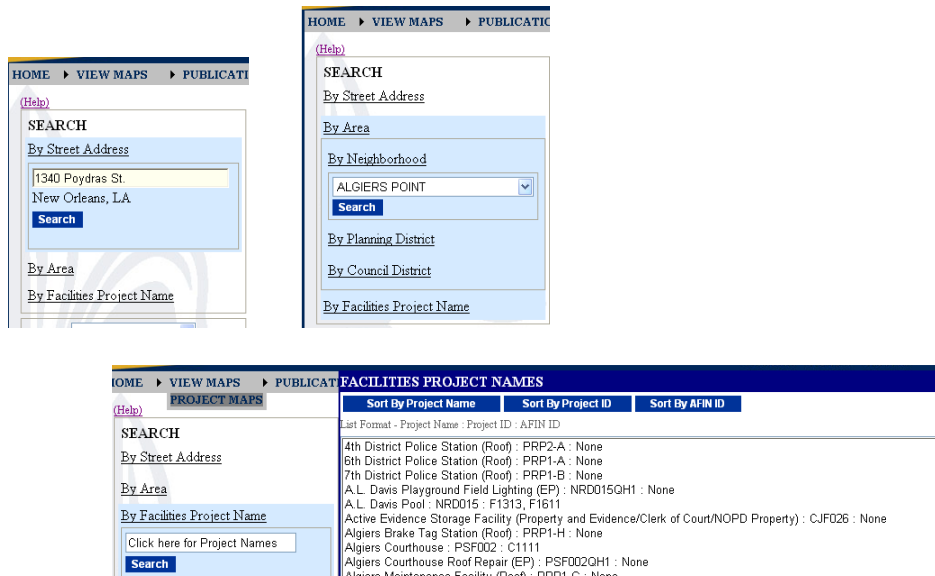


This map allows you to view current information on recovery-related projects throughout the City. To view the projects on the map:

- 1. Select the project(s) of interest under DPW and/or Facilities. Add miscellaneous (misc) GIS layers. After choosing projects select ‘Update Map’ to see locations on map.**



- 2. Search for projects by street address, by selecting an area from a drop down menu or by selecting a project name. When searching by project name, you may sort list by project name, project ID or Afin ID. Select ‘Search’ to trigger map to zoom to specified area or location.**



- 3. To create a report of project(s) and cost(s), both project and area search must be**

activated (as in steps #1 and #2). Selecting 'Create Report' will generate a report showing costs for all projects (Step 1) selected within the area specified (Step 2). A corresponding map will also be generated.

Map Control Tools

The following are standard map control tools. The tools are explained in order of how they appear



Zoom In: Zoom in to areas on the map. More detail will be displayed for the area within the zoom rectangle.

Zoom Out: Zoom out to areas on the map. More area and less detail will be displayed for the area within the zoom rectangle.

Zoom to Project Area: Zoom to furthest extent of project area.

Pan: Stay at same zoom level but pan/move around to different areas of the map.

Map Back Extent: Go to last map extent.

Map Forward Extent: Used in conjunction with Map Back Extent. Allows user to get back to Map Forward Extent once they have used the Map Back Extent.

Identify: Allows user to select individual features (projects) on the map and get more detailed information.

Print Map: Allows user to print current map display.
